Since the implementation of the Memorandum of Understanding and its final installation, our department has been able to access offender records utilizing the Eagle software. By accessing the information directly, our respective departments have saved countless man hours, not to mention the expenditure of incidental expenses such as paper, ink etc. for our respective departments. We no longer have to print our request, mail it, and then have someone in your department expend man hours to gather the information, print it, and then submit back to us. By making use of existing resources, we have been able to "work smarter" and save taxpayer dollars along the way.
